

A 13 CLAUSES INCREASING LIABILITY

Contrary to the provisions of article 3.4. of the General Conditions in respect of a hold-harmless clause, this insurance covers the liability of the insured for loss or damage arising from terms and conditions on which:

- materials, machinery and equipment, buildings, grounds and/or persons have been made available to the insured (whether against payment or not);
- property has been made available (whether against payment or not) or delivered to the insured;
- the insured takes part in exhibitions, fairs etc.;
- services have been provided to the insured, activities have been performed for the insured etc.;
- licences and/or concessions have been granted to the insured to perform activities, provide services etc. in a specific manner and/or on a specific location.

The VNAB model policy conditions and clauses only serve as **model**. They may be adjusted by alterations, additional provisions and/or clauses. VNAB market parties are free to offer other policy conditions to their customers.
